*The historical neighbourhood of Kallio in Helsinki has transformed from a working-class district to a haven of trends for students and artists.*

We start our tour from Helsinki Railway Station and head off to the laidback and bohemian neighbourhood of Kallio. Kallio district is packed with coffeehouses, restaurants, bars, and a multitude of little boutiques. Antiquarian bookshops and public saunas bring colour to the streets. Kallio is real, honest, and rustic.

During our tour we visit the only two-storey **Market Hall** in Finland and the art nouveau **Kallio Church** where the bells toll with music by Sibelius. The **Kotiharju Public Sauna** is the only remaining woodburning neighbourhood sauna in Helsinki.

**Kallio Library** with its rainbow bookshelves and domed roof is well worth seeing! The most popular parks in Kallio are the **Tokoinranta Park** and the **Karhupuisto Park** which transforms into a communal living room during festivities and events.

During our tour we stop for a coffee and a snack in one of the coffeehouses or restaurants in the area.
