This tour will take you around the City Centre of Helsinki introducing you to the story and the highlights of the city.

The tour will take you past the Design Museum with a little secret regarding the history of the Finnish education system. From there we head towards the Esplanade Park, where people have been promenading since the 19th Century. We will pass the statue of J.L. Runeberg, Finland's national poet and hear some stories of his life, before heading on towards the Central Market place. Further on we stand at the gates of the President's Palace, if the guards are on duty and the flag flies, we might even get a glimpse of the President himself. Then we move on to the Senate Square with all its fine buildings. We continue past Helsinki University towards the Railway Station Square, with its National Theatre and National Gallery and of course not forgetting The Railway Station itself designed by Eliel Saarinen one of Finland's most well known Architects. Then on towards the Mannerheimintie where we see the Parliament Building and the Public library Oodi. We end our tour on the Kamppi square.

During our tour you may find places you would like to visit later such as shops or good places to eat as well as knowing a little bit more about the city and its people.
